

## **Visiting Research Assistant Professor of Marine Science , University of North Carolina Wilmington**

The University of North Carolina Wilmington (UNCW) invites applications for a Visiting Research Assistant Professor in the Department of Geography and Geology, and the Center for Marine Science. The primary responsibility of this position is to conduct research in collaboration with UNCW faculty and students. Research must be complementary to on-going work (<http://www.uncw.edu/earsci.html>) and priority will be given to those applicants working in the field of marine science. The position also includes a required teaching component of at least one course per semester to be assigned by the department chair. Candidates are expected to have completed a Ph.D. by **August 2011**. Salary for this position is \$40,000 per 12 months plus benefits.
