

The Douglas Daniels Endowed Geosciences Scholarship and Award

This endowment was established in honor of Douglas Daniels, who supported the Geosciences Department throughout his career as a geologist. Scholarships will be awarded to at least an undergraduate junior enrolled in the Department of Geosciences with a declared major in Geology. The successful applicant will have a minimum overall GPA of 2.8 with a minimum GPA in Geology courses of 3.2.

Scholarships will be awarded for a) tuition, fees, and books at WMU; b) funding geological research projects; c) geologically related activities that are in keeping with the spirit and intent of the Douglas Daniels Scholarship.

Applicants must complete the application form; provide a complete copy of college/university transcripts; provide two references; and complete a paragraph as outlined on the application form. The deadline for application is Monday, March 15, 2010. The scholarship will be awarded at the Geosciences Department banquet on Friday, April 23, 2010.
